In this article, I will evaluate  $\square$  different types of places with these criteria  $\square$ , including benefits  $\cong$  and limitations  $\bowtie$ , and have sorted  $\square$  them based on my rankings  $\cong$  in descending order.

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#### 1. Library

Library is my first choice because it is designed for studying and reading.

This place is suitable for tasks  $\overline{y}$  that need to be done alone  $\overline{y}$  and require focus  $\overline{y}$  and concentration (i.e. distraction can significantly lower  $\overline{y}$  productivity).

The Benefits of a Library are:

- High-speed WiFi is Provided
- Enough Light ?
- Enough Places to Put Items
- Comfortable Desk and Chair

- Has Many Books as Decorations

However, there are some limitations, like:

My Rating for Café or Tea Shop is 5 out of 5.

However, the limitations are:

- Sometimes Noisy due to Discussion

My Rating for restaurant is 4 out of 5.

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### 6. Transportation

The next one is transportation  $\underline{\blacksquare}$  as you can utilise your free time  $\overline{\mathbb{Z}}$  while travelling.

The Benefits of Transportation are:

- Sometimes has Charging Ports
- Scenery Outside Window Provides Decorations

However, there are a lot of limitations. For example:

- WiFi may Not be Available
- May Not have Enough Light 💡
- May Not have Enough Places ito Put Items

- Desk and Chair may be Narrow or Desks may be Unavailable
- Sometimes Noisy due to Friction of Cars
- Sometimes Electronic Devices may be Restricted (1), like on some airlines
- May Arrive and so Tasks may be Stopped at Any Time \( \bigsiz \)

My Rating for transportation is 3 out of 5.

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#### 7. Park 🌲

Park & is also a place to study  $\geqslant$  and enjoy the natural scenery &, sound  $\leqslant$  and decorations  $\sim$ .

You can read books or articles and remember flashcards while sitting on the seat along the roads.

The Benefits of a Park are:

- Food and Drinks Allowed to Boost Energy
- Quiet (about 45-60 dB) so Zero Distraction
- Natural Scenery provides Decorations
- Can Stay for a Long Time \( \otimes\)
- Natural Sound provides 'Music'
- Sometimes has Peer Pressure

However, there are a lot of limitations. For example:

- WiFi may be Unavailable
- May Not have Places to Put Items
- Desk and Chair may be Unavailable
- Charging Ports may be Unavailable
